Protests shall be in the form of a written letter, no facsimiles or telegraphic protests will be allowed, and a bond, made payable to the board, in the amount equal to $5 \%$ of the contract amount or $\$ 2,000.00$ whichever is greater, not to exceed $\$ 5,000.00$ shall accompany the protest.
