#### **PROGRAM DESIGN AND MANAGEMENT**

##### **Enrollment**

##### **HSPS 45CFR 1305.4(a)(b1)(2)(b3)**

- There have been 5 student withdrawals during the month of March.
- Average monthly attendance for March 2013:
  - Early Head Start – 82.81%
  - Head Start – 85.84 %

##### **Fiscal**

- The Head Start Budget was submitted to the Finance Office. On March 1, the budget was in place for the grant period March 2013-February 2014.

#### **EARLY CHILDHOOD DEVELOPMENT AND HEALTH SERVICES**

##### **Education**

- After a unit on space, many of the Head Start Students traveled to the Pensacola State College Planetarium for a “Little Star” experience.
- Opal Ringo, Florida Early Childhood Education Specialist, conducted training on *A Systems Approach to School Readiness*.

##### **Student and Family Services**

- Developmental Screenings for height, weight, and BMI are conducted and tracked (3) three times a year. The 3<sup>rd</sup> Developmental Screenings will be conducted during the month of April.
- All Nutrition Care Plans have now been updated and completed for all students with special dietary needs.
- During the week of March 4-8, 2013, we celebrated National School Breakfast Week. The theme for the week was “BE A STAR WITH SCHOOL BREAKFAST.”
- Students are presently in the “Treatment phase” of dental visits with the exception of any new students enrolling in our program.

##### **Social/Emotional Development (Mental Health)/ESE/Disabilities**

- A Behavior Intervention In-service with Guest Speakers, Celeste Rivenbark and Laura Brumfield, Licensed Behavioral Analyst was conducted to provide training on Behavior Management and Intervention.
