What the grant will accomplish and the target groups to be served:

Ninth graders identified as at-risk to graduate swill be targeted, A series of 16 parent/student workshops will be provided. These workshops will be devoted to encouraging students to stay in school until graduation, avoiding risking behaviors, and providing opportunities to learn about the advantages of the high school diploma. Students who have families attending all 16 workshops will be loaded a Nexus tablet to use during their 10th grade year to enhance their educational experience. The purpose of the grant is to increase the likelihood of high school graduation, maintain an acceptable GPA, and accrue graduation credits.
