SAFETY

Bus Stop Evaluation

- Clear line of site
 - Free from obstructions
- Recognition time
 - No curves
 - No hills
- Controllable traffic
 - Minimum stops on Highways

Criteria met - Bus stop approved





SAFETY

Rainy Day/Inclement Weather

- Traffic (Buses) move slower in poor weather
- On-Time rate negatively effected

Rainy Day/Inclement Weather Safety Concerns

Door to Door Pick-Up & Drop-Off

- Around the corner (line of site)
- Over the hill (distance recognition)

 - Installation scheduled for 20 March 2014


