## Nutrient Standards for Sides or Snacks



### Calories:

$\leq 200$  calories

### Total Fats:

$\leq 35\%$  of total calories per portion

### Saturated Fats:

$\leq 10\%$  of total calories per portion

### Trans Fats:

zero grams per portion ( $\leq 0.5$  g per portion)

### Sodium:

$\leq 230$  mg sodium per portion (will change to 200 mg in 2015)

### Sugar:

$\leq 35\%$  of weight from total sugars per item
