Nutrient Standards for Sides or Snacks



Calories:

≤ 200 calories

Total Fats:

$\leq 35\%$ of total calories per portion

Saturated Fats:

$\leq 10\%$ of total calories per portion

Trans Fats:

zero grams per portion (≤ 0.5 g per portion)

Sodium:

≤ 230 mg sodium per portion (will change to 200 mg in 2015)

Sugar:

$\leq 35\%$ of weight from total sugars per item
