

In January of 1964, President Lyndon B. Johnson declared

"The War on Poverty" in his State of the Union speech.

Shortly thereafter, Sargent Shriver took the lead in assembling a panel of experts to develop a comprehensive child development program that would help communities meet the needs of disadvantaged preschool children.

"On May 18, 1965, it was a sunny, 70 degree Tuesday in the Rose Garden of the White House. President Lyndon Johnson announced Project Head Start and gave Sargent Shriver the go-ahead to enroll 100,000 children in the first Head Start programs."

"No one really understood just how powerful the need for Head Start would be. By June, 1965, there were 2,700 Head Start programs and by the end of the summer, 560,000 Head Start children had been enrolled!"

"In the fifty years since, Head Start has given more than 31 million children an opportunity for success in school and in life. That is a remarkable national achievement, in which every member of the Head Start community should take pride."
