March 10, 2015	Proposed Advertisement Period (4 advertisements in local newspapers). The school principals will communicate with parents and review the proposed changes with the School Advisory Council and PTA/PTO
April 23, 2015	Proposed Public Hearing at regularly scheduled School Board Meeting
	Possible approval of proposed boundary changes
April – May	Pending approval, Transportation develops revised bus routes for impacted areas
April 2015	Communicate with parents in impacted area via a letter that requires a return response regarding school preference for the upcoming year for impacted students that are currently attending a rezoned school

Information:

- Maps will be placed at each school site indicating the proposed boundaries for each impacted school.
- Once boundary adjustments have been approved the students will be notified by mail.
- The students who are zoned to a different school due to the boundary changes will have an opportunity to remain in their current school zone if they were a student in the prior year. The parent/guardian would be required to provide transportation. These students may remain at that school through the school's highest grade level if the parents choose to continue each year to provide transportation.
- An "intent" form will be mailed to this group of students on which parents would indicate if they wish for their child to remain in their current school or attend the newly zoned school. Students wishing to stay would be required to also have a district approved "Reassignment Form" on file.
- Newly enrolling students in the impacted zones would be expected to register and attend school in the revised zone area.
