


NARRATIVE SECTION

Project Design-Narrative

Santa Rosa School District will use these project funds to directly support the vision and goals of the current Digital Classroom Plan (DCP).

Initiatives Include:

- Preparing students for success in a global society
- Ensure students readiness to learn at all levels
- Provide a technology rich learning environment to enhance student achievement
- Maximize the learning potential of all students by providing equal access to instruction, using a comprehensive and innovative curriculum in a safe learning environment
- Guiding students to become self-directed, lifelong learners
- Support transition to computer-based assessments

The mission of the SRCD DCP is to provide a supportive framework that guides in developing a dynamic technological culture that empowers learners, including those with special needs, enhances learner outcomes and encourages independent and cooperative life-long learning. This framework will guide the use and implementation of technologies to enhance student achievement through correlation with curriculum, instruction and the Florida State Standards.

It is our vision that all Santa Rosa County learners will have access to current and emerging technologies, which enhance learning as a seamless element of the school day to promote higher order thinking skills to prepare students for college and careers.

Project Specifications and Commitments:

Project 1: Student Devices

The DCP provides for a 1-1 student to computer/device ratio for all SRC learners by 2017-18. This project will provide STEM equipment (student devices) in twenty SRC schools, four classrooms per school. This initiative will allow four teachers in each school to become Stem Integration Specialists at their grade level, serving as a model for others in the school and district. Classrooms selected for this project will receive student devices that will be used along with other classroom computers currently in place to approach our desired 1-1 goal. Training and support for the curriculum initiatives will be provided by the district.

These learning lab classrooms – per the vision in the DCP – will be implemented in the 15-16 school year. Students will become 21st Century learners, engaging in real-world learning experiences. Students will have access to educational applications and cloud storage using Office 365 on the devices. Students will be able to write reports, create lessons or collaborate with groups, updating and sharing their files from anywhere. The device will become the container, providing for a multitude of digital collaboration and creation tools. Learning lab teachers will facilitate Professional Learning Communities involving teachers in each of the 20 schools. They will serve as leaders, modeling true STEM instruction.

These devices requested in this proposal comply with the minimum performance requirements designated by the state department.

Project 2: Technology Bandwidth and Wireless Infrastructure

The district continues to provide financial resources for project #2 and will not be addressed in this proposal.

Project 3: Software and Licenses for student computers or classroom digital learning

The district continues to provide financial resources for project #3 and will not be addressed in this proposal.


