Santa Rosa School District is eligible for the first time to submit a proposal for a 21 st Century Community Learning Center (CCLC) Grant. If awarded, the grant will serve students at King Middle, Central School and Milton High School. Focused on Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts and Mathematics, the grant will provide project-based learning activities, field trips, tutoring and instruction from teachers, incorporating robotics, to name a few. Through its 21 st CCLC, titled <i>CreationStation</i> , at three school campuses selected for their academic needs and lack of services. CreationStation will engage students in four thematic areas, each of which includes STEAM and literacy as well as the arts and lasts for a quarter of the school year. These themes - Grow! Tech! Build! Animate! – draw on the district's unique features, from its agricultural economy to its technology future. Student goals include academic improvement as well as the development of resiliency and persistence in participating students. technology future.
