Where are we going?

ON TIME PERFORMANCE:

- GEO-Fencing:
 - A feature in a software program
 - Uses the global positioning system (GPS) to define geographical boundaries
 - A geo-fence is a virtual barrier
 - Allows an administrators to set up <u>triggers</u> so when a device enters (or exits) the boundaries defined by the administrator a text message or email alert is sent



GEO-Fence applicationsWhere are we going?

FLEET Management:

- Records geo-fence crossings to document proper route adherence
- When a bus driver alters his or her route
 - Dispatcher receives an alert
 - Initiates radio contact
 - Resolves the dilemma
 - Emergencies
 - Unauthorized route alteration
 - Excessive traffic delays
