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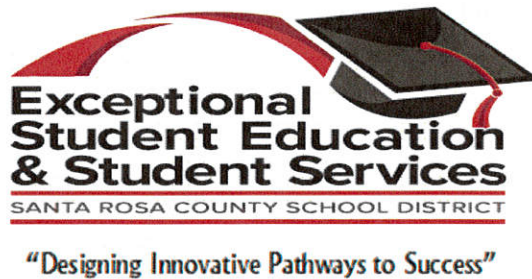

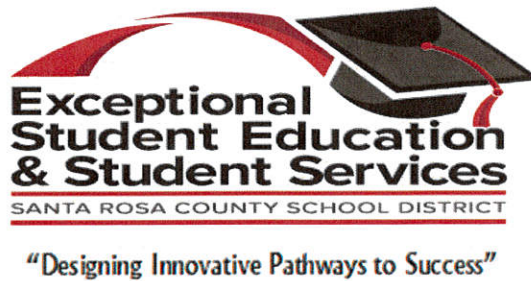

This memorandum is to provide a request for the continuous financial support of funds allocated to the thriving Gifted Program. Numerous activities were implemented last school year to offer opportunities to students, parents, community partners, instructional staff, and administrators. The following are examples of the activities accomplished during the 2015-2016 school year:

- Gifted Seminar/Webinar – provided training in the areas of advanced on-line education for gifted individuals, Sims Middle School
- Community Involvement – established business partnership with the gifted education in SRC; businesses provided funds to support gifted education for our District
- District Meetings – held throughout the school year to provide updates for elementary and secondary school communities about gifted education
- Parent Nights – provided training for parents of gifted students (expectations and vision)
- Professional Development – provided training for teachers of gifted students on Differentiated Instruction, Social-Emotional Support, and specific Gifted Characteristics

- Universal Screener – targeted second grade students at selected schools to extend option to students who may meet the criteria for additional testing for gifted services

The approximate financial support required to sustain the efforts to enhance the Gifted Program is \$70,000. This amount will allow additional opportunities to collaborate with the District's STEAM initiative, enhance gifted services at all instructional levels, and to inform the school community about the specific academic/social-emotional needs of our unique gifted population.
