Record Keeping

- Twenty-one (21) Child Plus reports distributed this month consisted of health/dental, education/assessment, end of
 the year, and student information. The reports were generated to help monitor several service areas of Head
 Start/Early Head Start.
- Eighteen (18) Head Start/Early Head Start applications for the 2012-2013 school year continue to be entered into Child Plus.

EARLY CHILDHOOD DEVELOPMENT AND HEALTH SERVICES

Education

- Head Start five-year-old students were provided the opportunity to experience Disney on Ice at the Pensacola Civic
 Center. This was a wonderful adventure for our students. Head Start four-year-old students took a field trip to the
 Panhandle Butterfly Garden. They saw many types of butterflies and had a picnic at a nearby park. Both field trips were
 a huge success with students and families.
- Galileo and VPK assessments have been completed. Teachers met with parents to provide information on assessment
 results and other pertinent information. Family goals and the status of those goals were also discussed during the
 meeting.
- Head Start and Early Head Start students and families participated in a Science Fair at T. R. Jackson Pre-K School.
 Teachers presented hands-on science activities with directions for doing the activity at home. Some of the activities included making ooblick, planting, water and wind projects, investigating the state of matter, and much more. Everyone enjoyed getting their "hands dirty" as they explored the world of science.
- Transitioning to kindergarten is very significant to Head Start and Voluntary Pre-K (VPK) students and families. Many students participated in graduation and promotion ceremonies as they prepare for that next step into kindergarten.
- Assessment data results indicate that students have reached the advanced level in all areas of development. Head Start
 mandates that readiness goals be written in alignment with the Head Start Child Development Early Learning
 Framework, the Florida State Standards, and the Local Education Agency. These goals must also be written in five
 specified domains. Data results and student progress toward meeting these goals are reported to the Head Start
 Regional Office. The analysis of the data indicates the following:
 - * approaches to learning 95%
 - * social and emotional development 85%
 - * language and literacy 90%
 - * cognition and general knowledge 83%
 - * physical and motor development 90%.

Health/Dental/Nutrition

- Field Day was held at Central School. Pictures were taken of students participating in scooter races, sack races, frisbee toss and relay races. Other ODS completed their field days in April.
- Jeff Mathews from the Santa Rosa County Extension Program provided nutrition lessons on myplate.gov for students at T. R. Jackson. Students were given coloring sheets of myplate to color and to help learn about the five food groups.
- Head Start Pre-K students for T. R. Jackson and other designated sites attended a field trip to Pensacola Civic Center to see "Disney on Ice". All service areas provided assistance with this field trip.
- Assistance was provided to all Pre-K Celebration/Graduation ceremonies to help teachers serve refreshments to parents and other family members.
- Heights and Weights for students at West Navarre Intermediate, Central School, Berryhill Elementary, Chumuckla Elementary and East Milton Elementary were measured and completed for the 2011-2012 school year.

- Currently there have been twenty-seven (27) Early Head Start Transition meetings held and two (2) ESE Transition meetings. Of the twenty-seven (27) Early Head Start Transition meetings, thirteen (13) resulted in a request to move to the Head Start Program for three-year olds pending an opening.
- Parent Talk meetings were held at T. R. Jackson, East Milton and Berryhill Elementary. Discussion topics such as Kindergarten Transition were facilitated by Gail Patterson, Mental Health Professional and the Social/ Emotional and ESE Area Specialist.

- Site visits were conducted at East Milton, Berryhill Elementary, Central School, Chumuckla Elementary, West Navarre Intermediate and Bagdad Elementary. The visits consisted of ESE staffings, transition meetings and classroom visits regarding student behavior and teacher/staff support.
- The annual Kindergarten Transition Meeting was held at T. R. Jackson with Sherry Diamond, Director of Elementary Education, serving as guest speaker. Information regarding kindergarten registration was given to our parents as well as contact information regarding school zones, busing and school lunches. Follow-up parent meetings were offered for those who could not attend the transition meeting.

FAMILY AND COMMUNITY PARTNERSHIPS

- The Family Service Liaisons have completed the final home visit and parent/teacher conferences for this school year.
- Under the direction of the Education and Assessment service area, Family Service Liaisons are preparing for Pre-K graduation and Promotion ceremonies at all 4-year old Head Start classrooms district-wide.
