Healthy Hunger Free Kids Act

Nutrition Requirements

The new rule requires most schools to increase availability of fruits, vegetables, whole grains, and fat-free and low-fat fluid milk in school meals; reduce the levels of sodium, saturated fat and trans fat in meals; and meet the nutrition needs of school children within their calorie requirements.

- USDA final rules with require changes
 - Increased whole grains
 - Increased fruits/vegetables offerings
 - Lower sodium in meals over 10 years
 - Breakfast meal changes
 - Some changes phased over 3 years

Healthy Hunger Free Kids Act (HHFKA)



Nutrition Education

- Sodexo in partnership with UF/IFAS Extension FNP offered hassle free scheduling and trained nutrition educators to provide nutrition education to students.
 - Knowledge improvements assessed with pre & post tests



Nutrition Education Survey Results

- **Pre- Test**

- 395 scored 100%
- 446 scored 80%
- 236 scored 60%
- 147 scored 40%
- 85 scored 20%
- 10 scored 0%

- **Post Test**

- 677 scored 100%
- 385 scored 80%
- 104 scored 60%
- 35 scored 40%
- 22 scored 20%
- 0 scored 0%

Nutrition Education
