## STUDENT PROGRESSION PLAN

4.11\*+

The School Board shall approve the <u>Student Progression Plan</u>, and copies shall be maintained in the District office and at each school. The Plan shall be pursuant to Florida Statutes and shall be comprehensive to include student performance standards and promotional and graduation requirements for Grades K-12, adult and general education, exceptional student education, dual enrollment, job entry, and vocational education <u>including technical education</u>. The plan shall include options for virtual instruction, academic acceleration and early high school graduation. After School Board approval, the District's <u>Student Progression Plan</u> shall be made a part of this policy.
