Santa Rosa School district will receive \$3,818,768.42 (Grant Period March 13, 2020-September 30, 2022) The district must use CARES Act funding for the following activities:

1. Assess student learning gaps resulting from disruption in educational services caused by COVID-19.
2. Accelerate student learning, with identification of evidence-based/research-informed strategies for closing student achievement gaps.
3. Ensure the safety and health of all students and staff served.
4. Support the Instructional Continuity Plan (ICP), which must outline steps for ensuring continued instruction, including the district's plan for remote learning.
5. Provision of charter school support, including the dissemination and assurance of allowable uses of funds.
6. Provision of equitable services, including the timeline for consultation and the steps districts will take to notify eligible non-public schools of the opportunity to participate in consultation and to receive services.
