PURPOSE The purpose of this Amendment is to add language to the original Agreement, approved by the School Board on September 19, 2017, that allows Escambia County and Santa Rosa County to mutually provide Title I services to eligible private school students without charge unless the number of students served exceeds twenty-five (25) students. This Amendment has been developed with input from the Title I Director in Santa Rosa County and provides mutual benefit for both counties. The number of Title I private school students that cross county lines to be served is minimal and does not warrant the formal reimbursement process outlined in the original Agreement.			
IMPLEMENTATION PLAN For purposes of this Agreement, the district in which the student resides will be called the “Resident District”. The district in which the student attends will be called the “Receiving District”. Private school students, parents, and teachers will continue to be provided equitable services and all requirements of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act and related regulations and guidance will be met by the Receiving District on behalf of the Resident District, in return for compensation from the Resident District. Reimbursement between Escambia County and Santa Rosa County will not take place unless more than twenty-five (25) students are served by either district.

AMENDMENT TO THE

WHEREAS, the parties having entered into an agreement approved by the BOARD on September 19, 2017; and

WHEREAS, present circumstances make it appropriate that the terms of said contract should be amended.

THEREFORE, the parties agree to amend the contract as follows:

In the section titled "Responsibilities of Receiving District," amend item seven (7) to state "Invoice the Resident District for services provided (exclusive of administrative costs) if the number of students served exceeds twenty-five (25); or arrange for reciprocal services in equal monetary amount to private school students for whom the roles of Receiving and Resident District are reversed."

In the section titled "Responsibilities of Resident District," amend item two (2) to state "Annually reserve equitable funds for any verified eligible private school students by a Receiving District if the number of students served exceeds twenty-five (25)."
