## To Whom It May Concern:

The Santa Rosa County School District is the grantee for the Santa Rosa County School District's Head Start and Early Head Start Programs. It is the goal of this grantee to remain in compliance with the Head Start Program Performance Standards and other federal requirements at all times, thus providing students and their families with a quality preschool program emphasizing social and emotional development, health and safety practices, and school readiness.

Head Start Program Performance Standard 1303.72(a)(4) lists specific federal guidance for the operation of vehicles.

With the exception of transportation services to children served under a home-based option, there is at least one bus monitor on board at all times, with additional bus monitors provided as necessary.

In alignment with Head Start Performance Standard 1303.72(a)(4), the Santa Rosa County School District's Head Start and Early Head Start Program would like to request a waiver applicable for the period **March 1, 2022 - February 28, 2023** for the bus monitor requirement as mandated by Head Start Program Performance Standard 1303.72(a)(4). We request this waiver for the following reasons:

- The Santa Rosa County School District's Head Start and Early Head Start Programs have a collaborative agreement with the Santa Rosa County School District's contracted transportation provider, Student Transportation of America. This collaborative agreement provides bus transportation as in-kind to the Head Start Program for an estimated 28% of the total Head Start student population to and from school each day.
  - Any Head Start enrolled student who lives outside of a two-mile radius, but within a specified school zone in which a Head Start Program site is located, is eligible for District contracted bus transportation.
  - The Head Start and Early Head Start Programs located at the Santa Rosa School District's Pre-K Administrative site, T.R. Jackson Pre-K Center, rely solely on parent-provided student transportation to and from school each day. It should be noted that with this arrangement, the average monthly attendance for the Head Start and Early Head Start Programs have been 89% and 85% respectively. This can confirm that parent-provided transportation does not cause an attendance concern.

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- Of the contracted buses providing transportation to the Head Start Program, there are no more than five Head Start students on a bus at any time. The population of Head Start students transported via bus transportation to and from school each day represents 28% of the total population of Head Start students.
- Of the 40 Head Start students transported via the District's contracted transportation services, it
  would be considered a disruption in the program's daily operations to provide bus monitors for
  such a small percentage of students who are transported to and from school each day via
  contracted bus service provided as in-kind to the program.
- The in-kind support given by the Santa Rosa County District Schools through the transportation contracted services helps the Head Start Program to meet the grant matching requirements of the Head Start Performance Standard 1303.40.

We greatly appreciate the opportunities this grantee has been given to serve the Head Start and Early Head Start eligible children within our community. Award of this transportation waiver will allow us to continue to provide quality and efficient integrated services to all eligible participants.
