Dear School Board Members,

I am respectfully submitting the budget proposal for the 2022-2023 Flight Adventure Deck (FAD) Program for your approval.

The Flight Adventure Deck program is for sixth, seventh, and eighth grade mathematics and science students in Santa Rosa and Escambia counties. The FAD curriculum is grade level appropriate and based on Florida's Math \& Science standards. The program resides at NAS Pensacola - National Naval Aviation Museum - and is a collaborative effort between the Santa Rosa and Escambia School Districts and the Naval Aviation Museum Foundation (NAMF). The Foundation has invested over two million dollars in the Flight Adventure Deck for Smithsonian-caliber hands-on activities related to the mathematics and science of flight.

With your approval of this budget, we will begin our $26^{\text {th }}$ year of the FAD program. Since the beginning of this program in 1996, nearly 94,000 students from Escambia and Santa Rosa counties have attended. Nearly 3,200 SRCSD students benefited from this experience this year. We request your approval of funds for the salary and benefits of one teacher, as well as the buses and substitutes for two teachers per visit, in order to continue this outstanding program.

The allotments used for Substitutes and Buses/Drivers are based on the current rates and will not need to be increased unless the field trip or substitute rates change for school year 2022-2023.

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*The 2013-2014 school year was plagued with many issues beyond the control of those in charge of and those who participate in the Flight Adventure Deck program. These issues cost the program multiple available dates and resulted in numerous cancellations. The issues are as follows:

- Sequestration, which affected 2 Mondays during the month of September.
- Government Shutdown, which affected 13 days in October, resulting in the cancellation of 13 scheduled student days. Some of these were able to reschedule, others were not.
- Snow Days, which affected January $28-30$, resulting in the cancellation of 3 scheduled dates.
- Museum maintenance shutdown, which affected February 26, resulting in the cancellation of 1 scheduled date.
- Flood Days, which affected April 30, May 1, 2, resulting in the cancellation of 3 scheduled dates.
- The month of April was virtually unavailable this year due to the length of FCAT testing, which previously only affected $1-2$ weeks of school.
- These issues resulted in the loss of 8 total dates for Santa Rosa County due to the lack of suitable available dates in which to reschedule those teachers.

- On December 6, 2019, an active shooter aboard NAS Pensacola killed three sailors and wounded others. This act closed the base entirely and then reopened only to military personnel and others with DoD IDs. Capt. Kinsella did grant permission to allow us to bring students back onboard on January 8, 2020 if accompanied by someone with an active DoD ID. Fieldtrips between December 6 and January 8 were affected by this act.
- On March 12, 2020, due to an outbreak of COVID-19 the National Naval Aviation Museum Foundation and both school districts shut down normal operations. This eliminated all fieldtrip dates post March 12.

**Bus driver shortages and substitute teacher shortages resulted in transportation policy changes in Escambia County: now all ESC buses must depart no later than 12:10pm to ensure their readiness with securing additional bus routes later in the day (exception - if the school can provide an internal bus driver, students may stay for the entirety of the trip). Possible solution: A resolution would be to dedicate a bus and driver solely for the purposes of Flight Adventure Deck transportation.
*During the $1^{\text {st }}$ nine weeks of school, Escambia County students were not permitted to attend any FAD fieldtrips due to Escambia County protocol.
*The Escambia County TSA resigned his position in November 2021. Escambia County was unable to fill this position for the remainder of the 2021-2022 school year. Two substitutes were utilized in his stead.
