

**NOTICE OF PROPOSED DECLARATION OF REAL PROPERTY AS SURPLUS AND  
AUTHORIZATION OF SALE UNDER AGREEMENT FOR SALE AND PURCHASE**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that The School Board of Santa Rosa County, Florida, proposes to declare certain vacant real property of the Board to be surplus and to reaffirm sale of such property under an Agreement for Sale and Purchase. The property is known as the Whisper Creek Tract; is located off the east side of Whisper Creek Boulevard, north of the Gulf Power Company electrical transmission line easement, Milton, Florida; and includes approximately 24.22 acres of land. An area map depicting the property is shown below.



A public hearing will be held on **September 8, 2022, at 6:30 p.m.**, or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, in the cafeteria at Central School, 6180 Central School Road, Milton, Florida, at which time the School Board will consider whether to declare the described property to be surplus and to approve an agreement to sell the property.

Any person who decides to appeal a decision made by the School Board regarding any matter considered at this meeting or hearing will need a record of the proceeding. For this purpose, an individual may need to ensure that a verbatim record of the proceeding is made, at the individual's own expense, which record includes the testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be based. See Section 286.0105, Florida Statutes.
