Domain: Approaches to Learning

Readiness Goal Outcome: Students will be able to master 75% of Readiness Goals in the knowledge area of Approaches to Learning to attain and sustain development and learning gains for school success and life-long learning.

Program Goal: Approaches to Learning: Students will be able to make and revise a plan, if needed; explore new materials; and, combine materials to produce multiple uses.

Domain: Cognitive Development and General Knowledge

Readiness Goal Outcome: Students will be able to master 75% of Readiness Goals in the knowledge area of Cognitive Development and General Knowledge to attain and sustain development and learning gains for school success and life-long learning.

Program Goal: Cognitive Development and General Knowledge: Students will be able to engage in cooperative play; express themselves through songs and movement; manipulate objects within a group; determine that one is missing from a group; sort objects by specific attributes and provide reasoning for their choices; solve everyday problems; take on different roles during play such as a character from a story; experiment with objects to see what will happen; and, place objects in different positions, when asked.

Domain: Language, Communication, Reading & Writing Readiness Goal Outcome: Students will be able to master 75% of Readiness Goals in the knowledge area of Language and Literacy to attain and sustain development and learning gains for school success and life-long learning.

Program Goal: Language, Communication, Reading & Writing: Students will be able to ask questions to communicate or to obtain information; retell a story; use basic rules of grammar in speech; request favorite books to be read and demonstrate basic book-handling knowledge; recognize that spoken words can be written are read; communicate by writing; and identify some letters in their names.

Domain: Physical Development and Health

Readiness Goal Outcome: Students will be able to master 75% of Readiness Goals in the knowledge area of Physical Development and Health to attain and sustain development and learning gains for school success and life-long learning.

Program Goal: Physical Development and Health: Students will be able to practice personal hygiene routines; participate in large motor activities; and, develop small motor skills.

Domain: Social and Emotional Development

Readiness Goal Outcome: Students will be able to master 75% of Readiness Goals in the knowledge area of Social and Emotional Development to attain and sustain development and learning gains for school success and life-long learning.

Program Goal: Social and Emotional Development: Students will be able to communicate about their families and the community in which they live; follow classroom rules and routines; demonstrate cooperative behaviors; self-regulate their behaviors; resolve conflicts; demonstrate appropriate behaviors while working in their environment; express themselves appropriately to peers; and, join a cooperative play activity using appropriate social skills.
