Dear Mr. Wyrosdick and School Board Members:

As you may know, each year interested parents of the graduating class of Milton High School have formed a committee to support "Project Graduation". Project Graduation is an all-night event held in a location which enables the graduates to celebrate together in a safe, drug and alcohol-free environment immediately following the graduation ceremony.

This year the seniors have chosen to have a dinner cruise. In order to accommodate all students who wish to attend, we contracted with a company out of Panama City, Florida, The Lady Anderson, which provided the largest possible venue.

In the past, the School Board has assisted Project Graduation in providing buses for transportation to the event. We would ask that the Board again provide transportation for the students to assist us in keeping the cost of the event as low as possible.

Gulf Breeze High School will once again organize a Project Graduation event for this year's graduating seniors—Class of 2013. In the past, the county has allowed us the use of school buses to transport the students to the event venue.
