### Healthy Hunger Free Kids Act of 2010 (HHFKA)

- February 1,2013, USDA, issued proposed regulations to establish nutrition standards for competitive food sales in schools.
- Competitive foods are defined as "all food and beverages, other than reimbursed meals, available for sale to students on the school campus during the school day". This includes ala carte, vending, fundraisers, snack stores, etc.
- Transition period on year, guidelines effective July 1, 2014.
- The proposed new rule meets current Alliance for Healthier Generation guidelines

# Healthy Hunger Free Kids Act of 2010 (HHFKA) Nutrition Standards

#### Calorie limits:

- Snack items < 200 calories</li>
- Entree items ≤ 350 calories

#### Sodium limits:

- Snack items <230 mg , 2016 <200 mg</li>
- Entrée items ≤ 480 mg

#### Fat limits:

- Total fat < 35% of calories</li>
- Saturated fat < 10% of calories</li>
- Trans fat : zero grams

#### Sugar limits:

- < 35% of weight from total sugars in foods</p>
- Accompaniments must included in the nutrient profile for each product (bagels w/cream cheese, jelly, butter, etc.)



### **Healthy Hunger Free Kids Act of 2010 (HHFKA)**

### Summary

- Potential decrease in ala carte sales
- Encourage more fruits/vegetables servings
- Flexibility for state and local communities
- Some flexibility for "traditional" events (birthdays, holiday,etc)
- Standards do not apply to non school hours, off campus events
- Special exemption for infrequent fundraising on campus. State agency determine frequency.

#### **New Point of Sale**

### Advantages

- Faster communication to the school site for free/reduced applications
- Email addresses can be added to data base
- Less intervention with food stamp cases
   Challenges
- Online payment system only allows payment to deposit funds into one account
- Flat fee to parents when using online payment system
