

CHAPTER 8.00 - AUXILIARY SERVICES

INSPECTIONS

8.14*

- I. All school buildings shall be inspected at least once during each school fiscal year by a person who is certified by the designated state agency. Such inspection shall be conducted to determine compliance with State Board of Education rules and shall include but not be limited to sanitation, wiring, plumbing, structural parts, safety hazards, and general repair needs. A copy of such inspection report(s) shall be submitted to the principal, Building Maintenance, Superintendent, and School Board.
- II. The principal or designee shall routinely inspect the alarm panel of the school. Any malfunction of the alarm system shall be reported immediately to the Maintenance department who shall make the needed repairs without delay. The faculty shall be notified that the intercom system will be used as a back-up until the alarm system is repaired.
