Our records indicate that 389 teachers have completed the district Add-On ESOL Endorsement from January 1, 2009 to April 4, 2014. A grand total of 543 teachers have completed the endorsement.

Adding this requirement to the contract has most definitely helped us in attaining a higher number of highly qualified ESOL teachers.
