Dear Superintendent Wyrosdick:

Your request to reduce the length of the school term by two days in accordance with rule 6A-1.09533, Florida Administrative Code (FAC), and section 1011.60(2), Florida Statutes (F.S.), has been approved by Commissioner Stewart. Rule 6A-1.09533, FAC, authorizes the Commissioner to reduce the length of the school term without a proportional reduction in funding when there are no remaining teacher planning days or school holidays, other than national or state holidays, in the official school year calendar. This approval is based upon the information provided in your May 1, 2014, letter regarding significant flooding and damage to school facilities due to a recent storm that required schools to close on April 30 and May 1, 2014.

In accordance with section 1011.60(2), F.S., schools must operate for 180 actual teaching days or the equivalent on an hourly basis to participate in the Florida Education Finance Program. Rule 6A-1.045111, FAC, specifies the hourly equivalent as not less than 720 net instructional hours for kindergarten through grade 3 and not less than 900 hours for grades 4 through 12. To ensure that the Santa Rosa County School District meets the requirements set by law in the future, please consider scheduling in excess of the maximum hourly requirements for your 2014-15 school district calendar.
