Program Summary:

“Bigs Inspiring Scholastic Success” will target male and female participants K-8th grade, five through fifteen (5-15) years of age, who need assistance in improving academic achievement in one or more areas of the FCAT. One-to-one mentoring services will be provided to the youth and delivered at school locations. Some anticipated outcomes will be eighty-five percent (85%) of mentored students will maintain or improve academic grades, eighty-five percent (85%) of mentored students will maintain or improve school attendance, eighty percent (80%) of students will show improvement on behavior evaluation and eighty percent (80%) of mentored students will be promoted to the next grade level.


