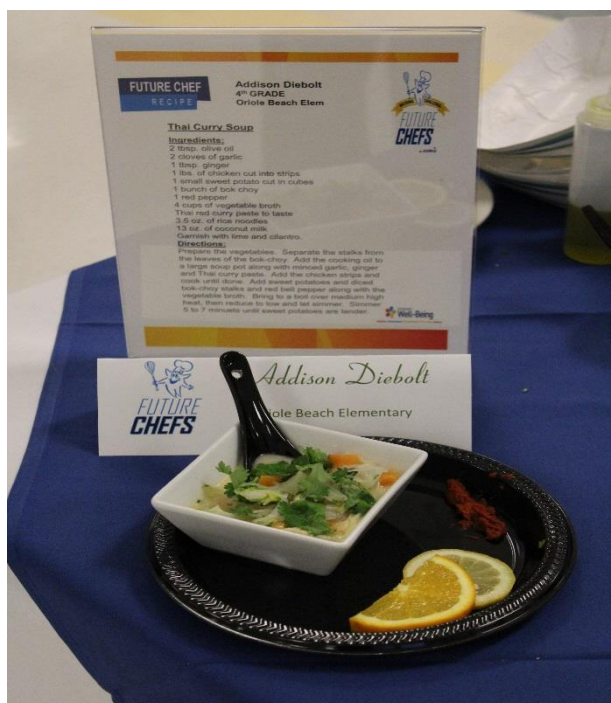

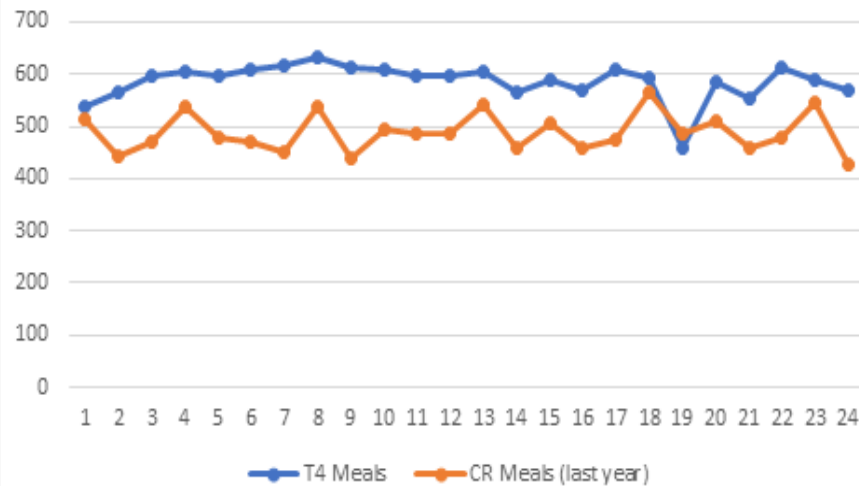
New Deli Station-

Fresh baked breads include Italian, Chipotle & Cheddar, Jalapeno & Cheddar. Students pick from variety of proteins, and toppings.

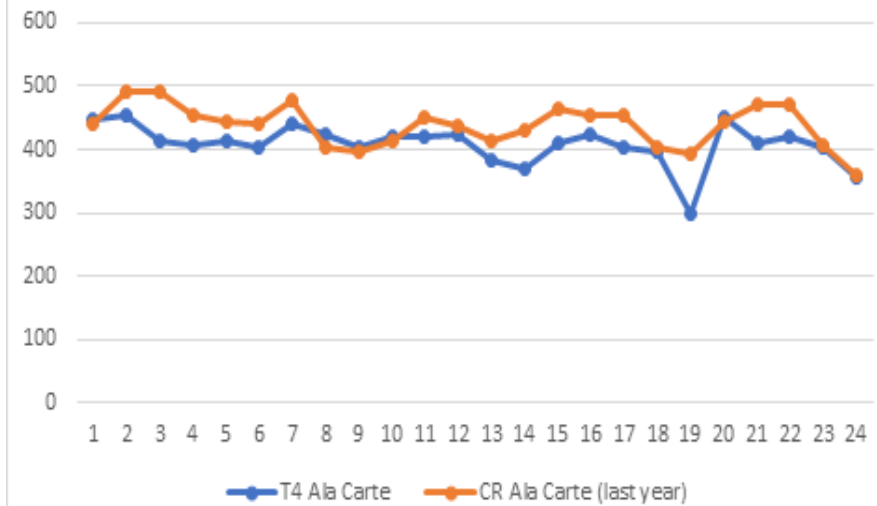
