The Title IV grant will focus on justice-involved students (students who are on probation, have been to Teen Court, or who are transitioning from a DJJ facility back into Santa Rosa County High Schools), as well as other identified at-risk youth. Services provided by a Student Intervention Specialist. will include: 1. Supporting college and career counseling, including CTE, providing information opportunities for financial aid through FAFSA; 2. Providing school-based mental health and counseling services; 3. Establishing or improving dropout prevention; 4. Promoting supportive school climates to reduce the use of exclusionary discipline; 5. Support the re-entry programs and transition services for justice-involved youth; 6. Developing relationship building to help improve safety through the recognition and prevention of coercion, violence, and abuse; and 7. Establishing community partnerships.
