Establishing or improving dropout prevention; 4. Promoting supportive school climates to reduce the use of exclusionary discipline; 5. Support the re-entry programs and transition services for justice-involved youth; 6. Developing relationship building to help improve safety through the recognition and prevention of coercion, violence, and abuse; and 7. Establishing community partnerships.
