# C. <u>REVIEW STATUS OF CURRENT PROJECTS:</u>

### 1. <u>Milton High School Track Replacement</u>

Project is nearly complete. A meeting was held on-site on 9/17 to review areas of new asphalt pavement that are in an unacceptable condition. The Contractor will be milling and replacing approximately 400 LF of asphalt pavement, scheduled to be complete Tuesday, 9/25. Nearly all sodding is complete, with remaining sod scheduled to be installed by 9/19. Striping schedule continues to be contingent upon completion of asphalt.

Based on documentation of weather-related delays provided by the Contractor to date, we estimate the contractual Final Completion date to be on or around 9/18. Liquidated Damages of \$500 per day will be assessed for any unwarranted delays.

# 2. <u>Pace High School Tennis Courts Replacement</u>

Construction is underway. Fence fabric, nets, benches and other miscellaneous features have been removed and stored elsewhere on site. Formwork is being installed in preparation of the post-tensioned concrete court installation. Receipt of engineered drawings for the post-tension system from the Contractor is pending.

## 3. <u>Woodlawn Beach Middle School Basketball Court and Drainage Repairs</u>

JHI is requesting Phase 1 approval. The scope of this project includes complete removal and reconstruction of the eastern half of the existing asphalt basketball court at Woodlawn Beach Middle School, including relocation of +/- 300 LF of underlying storm water pipe that has failed and is causing failure within the existing court. A bid alternate will be established for removal/replacement of +/- 500 LF of storm pipe beyond the limits of the court that is varying conditions of deterioration, although not causing any significant issues. Phase I Plans and an Opinion of Cost are attached to this agenda.
