D. REVIEW STATUS OF CURRENT PROJECTS:

1. Pace High School Tennis Courts Replacement

The post-tension slab for the second court battery has been installed, the sidewalks and ramps between the two court batteries have been installed, all fencing and gates have been re-installed, grading around the court perimeters for drainage is complete and all sodding is in place. A substantial completion inspection is being coordinated and is currently anticipated late in the week of 1/14.

Note that surfacing and striping of the courts is dependent on providing adequate cure time for the new post-tension slabs, and as such, this work remains outstanding at this time.

2. <u>Woodlawn Beach Middle School Basketball Court and Drainage Repairs</u> Currently in Phase III design. Targeting Summer construction schedule.
